- ◆ One Godparent **must be** Catholic
- ◆ Call Church Office for Registration
- ◆ You must be a member of the parish for at least six months

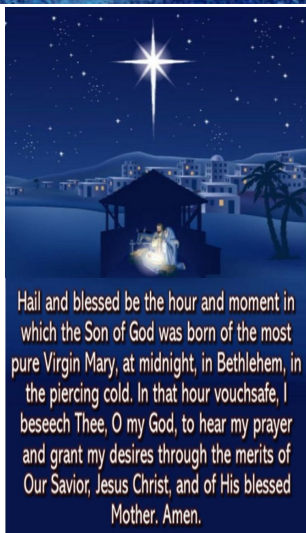

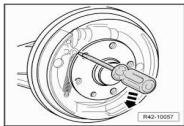
