- ◆ Ages: Newborn to 6 years of age
- ◆ Baptism Class held via ONLINE
- ◆ Baptism held as scheduled (after 4pm Mass on Saturday)
- ◆ One Godparent **must be** Catholic
- ◆ Call Church Office for Registration
- ◆ You must be a member of the parish for at least six months

### *RCIA*

- ◆ RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) is a process whereby adults learn about the Catholic Faith. If you would like to learn more about our Faith, Baptism, First Eucharist or Confirmation, please contact the Office.

### *Marriage Requirements*

- ◆ Member of Our Mother of Mercy
- ◆ Attend marriage preparation sessions with a sponsor couple
- ◆ Attend Engaged Encounter Weekend at the archdiocese
- ◆ Couple must see a priest or deacon six months prior to proposed date

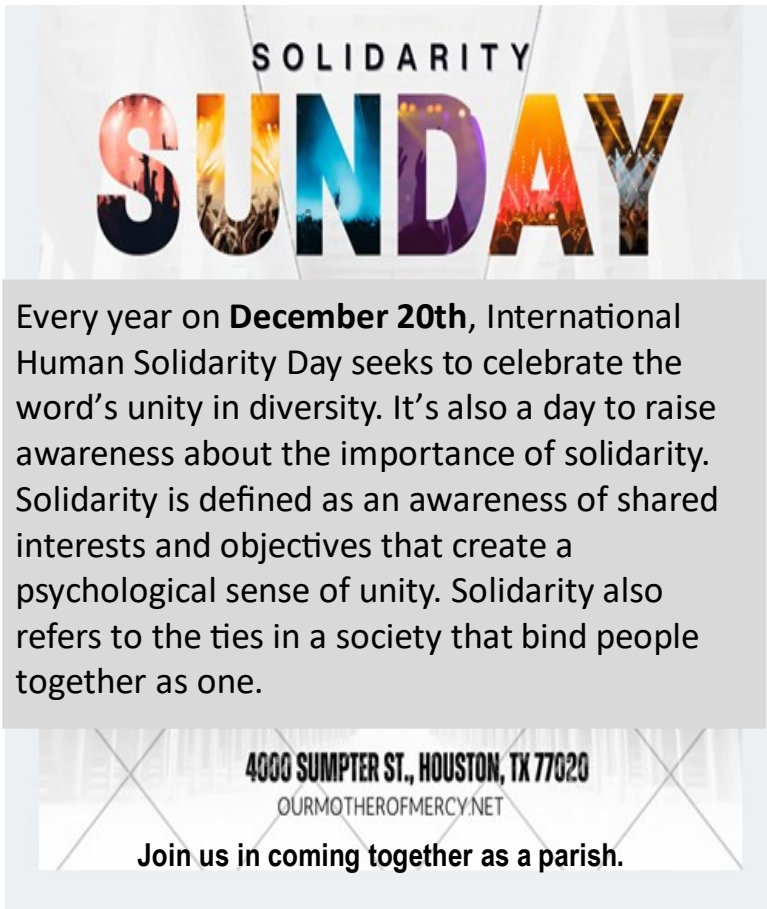


SOLIDARITY

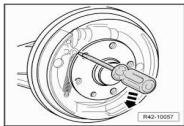
